Aim of General Nursing and Midwifery (GNM):

The basic aim of the diploma course in general nursing and midwifery is geared to the health need of the individual, family, community and society at large by preparing nurses with sound knowledge & skill to function as an efficient member of the health team through their personal and professional development with technological advancement.

Objectives:

The diploma nurse on completion of this course will be able to:

- ❖ Apply knowledge from physical, biological and behavioral sciences, medicine including alternative systems and nursing in providing care to individuals, families and communities.
- ❖ Provide nursing care based on steps of nursing process in collaboration with the individuals and groups.
- ❖ Provide promotive, preventive and restorative health services in line with the national health policies and programmes.
- ❖ Communicate effectively with individuals and groups and members of the health team in order to promote effective interpersonal relationship and teamwork.

Course Duration of GNM - 3 Years.

General Instructions for the students:
